




Peaceful quiet sunset on the bluff overlooking the Tennessee River in Jackson County \$341,250.00

In Jackson County, along the high river bluff across from the city of Scottsboro, is a small peaceful quiet property that over looks the Tennessee River and the Cumberland Plateau.

It is a very private 4 acre tract with TVA lands below and one great neighbor to the east through the woods. There is a 2000 sq ft double “A Frame” cabin with a pool that picks up all the reflections of the sky.






The cabin is 3 bedroom/ 2 bath home with a two car garage adjacent to the house and the pool, has a lovely cottage garden surrounding the entrance. The drive to the cabin is through large hardwoods. The field at the top of the drive is about 2 acres with an orchard and blueberries.

Life on the bluff is different with so much sky, so many birds and changing weather on an intimate level. The weather is cooler in the summer than other places in Alabama.



This small kitchen has cooked more meals for large crowds than larger kitchens. The breakfast room looks over the mountains on one side and the garden on the other side.





Heart pine floors are throughout the cabin. The living room has a wooden cathedral ceiling. The fireplace is one of the best ever that burns large wooden logs and does a good job of heating the house.

The house flows well with the kitchen, breakfast room and living area. The house has a new HVAC system but you hardly need it with cool breezes blowing through open windows.



The front door looks east facing a beautiful open custom wooden staircase.

The downstairs bath has a colorful Mexican sink on a longleaf countertop.





The master bedroom has skylights that allow you to keep windows open even in the rain. All bedrooms have large wooden ceiling fans.



Each of the upstairs bedroom has skylights as well as ceiling fans. The balcony is large enough to work as a room of it's own. The bathroom is between the two bedrooms. Some of the best views of the river are from these bedrooms as well as some of the best bird songs.





It is an amazing place with light and a view that is rare in Alabama. A place where you are part of the flyway for birds in the spring and ducks and geese in the fall. the breezes always blow and the birds sing. You can watch the eagles fly the length of the river and the rains come in the summer as they move down the river.
